- **3.1** Alliant Energy Re-Route Gas Line Away From Wrestling Room Addition Before April 1 Dr. Gray noted that there would be an additional cost for the upcoming renovation project for the addition of the wrestling room. There is a gas line in the area that needs to be rerouted at a cost of \$12,731.99, He said there would be a cost offset for the water lines, as Black Hawk Sprinklers has discovered six water lines in, four for the High School and two capped lines for the Middle School. So no additional water lines would need to come in the building for the sprinklers. Motion by Chitty, second by Anderson to approve paying the cost to move the gas line for \$12,731.99. Harter withdrew the motion on the floor, second by Maier. There was more discussion and the associate's pay schedule was narrowed to one. Motion by Harter to approve proposed pay schedule discussed last, second by Maier. Motion Carried 5-o
