## **NEVADA NURSES NEWS**

#### TO PARENTS OF INCOMING PRESCHOOLERS:

Please turn in a completed up-to-date immunization record as well as a current physical exam. We must have these on file before your child can begin school with us in the fall. You may drop them off to Central Elementary School or bring them to Preschool Preview night.

#### TO PARENTS OF INCOMING KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS:

lowa law requires that children enrolling in kindergarten are required to provide proof of a dental screening. A screening for kindergarten students is valid if it occurs no earlier than age 3 and no later than four months after the first day of school (Sept. 7, 2021). You can ask your dentist for a form at the time of your visit.

#### TO PARENTS OF INCOMING 7TH GRADERS:

All students entering 7th grade must have proof of having both Meningococcal vaccines and a TDAP (Tetanus, Diptheria and Pertussis) booster before school starts on September 7th. Please call your physician to get this done.

#### TO PARENTS OF CURRENT 9TH GRADERS:

lowa law requires that all 9th grade students need to provide proof of a dental screening. A screening for 9th grade is valid if it occurs one year prior to enrollment to four months after the first day of school (Sept. 7, 2021). A dental form is available at your dentist's office or at the school nurse's office.

#### TO PARENTS OF ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:

All students entering 12th grade must have proof of having the Meningococcal vaccines before the first day of school on September 7th . Some students already have the vaccines completed.

Some have yet to get their first dose. If you are unsure what your child needs please contact your physician or the school nurse's office. The vaccine can be completed at most clinics. Contact your physician to set up an appointment. Please bring in documentation to the nurse's office.

### FFA CONSERVATION FIELD DAY

The Nevada High School Agriculture Education department and FFA Chapter collaborated with several groups to host a conservation field day on Friday, July 2nd at the FFA DOT test plot south of Nevada. Farmers, urban residents, government officials, and ag product and service providers were able to learn about no-till farming, water infiltration, and soil conservation at the field day. Heartland Cooperative, Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS), and Van Wall Equipment all provided resources, interactive sessions, and equipment demonstrations. Nevada FFA members were in attendance greeting attendees and providing tours of their no-till sovbean field.


