2. Call to Order for regular Board meeting at 6:42 p.m.

3. Approval of Agenda The Board noted an additional item for the agenda, 6.6 Additional Sharing 2021-22, additional personnel, and a fundraiser. Motion by Chitty, second by Harter to approve the agenda as amended. Motion Carried 5-0

5.1 Middle School Remodel Update – Estes Construction Mr. Sharp reviewed the monthly report he had distributed for the Middle School Remodel update. He also reviewed the three change orders to be approved by the Board at this meeting.

6.1 Middle School Bulletin Board Replacement Quote Mr. Sneiderman noted that the intent was to re-use the bulletin boards from the Middle School but they were damaged when removed. He said he took bids from both Premier and Quill. The new bulletin boards are rubber tack rather than old cork board which means they'll last longer. The new marker boards don't have to be sprayed when they are wiped off. Motion by Chitty, second by Maier to approve the Premier bid of \$42,367 for the bulletin and marker boards. Motion Carried 5-0

6.2 Annual Review – Emergency Operations Plan Dr. Gray said the Board is required to review the Emergency Operations Plan each year. The changes for 2021-22 are adding Gates Hall and the Wrestling Room and changing, as needed, the personnel listed. Anderson asked about the availability of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in the Schools. Dr. Gray said that Mrs. Huber is working on a grant for more AEDs. Motion by Maier, second by Harter to approve the Emergency Operations Plan as updated for 2021-22. Motion Carried 5-0

6.6 Additional Sharing 2021-22 The Colo-NESCO District needs a teacher of record for its art curriculum. Administration is suggesting that .125 FTE position be purchased from Nevada by Colo-NESCO. Nevada's art teachers, Mr. Beauchene and Mrs. Young would use their prep period at \$25 per day and Colo-NESCO would be billed for their time. This would be for the Middle School/High School Art classes only. At the Elementary level, the classroom teachers will cover art with Mrs. Hillman's assistance.
