- > Infusing character education into the educational program

-**Central Elementary**: SEL Professional Development, Literacy Footprints implementation, continued PD with Jen Burns, FAST testing coming up (K-4 Reading and Math), and evaluating Math curriculum programs w/site visits - Bridges and enVisions.

-**Nevada Middle School**: SEL Professional Development, FAST testing for 5-8 students (Reading and Math), MTSS focus - Literacy, Math, and Behaviors, and the Cafeteria is open!

-**Nevada High School**: SEL Professional Development, Summative/Formative Assessment work, implementing classroom visits by teachers (grow from your own), 22-23 School Year Prep - course orientation, course requests, develop Master Schedule, and 1-on-1 scheduling meetings for students, and provide an activities/athletics update.
