-Nevada Middle School: Hired five new teacher for next year - construction under way - the entire MS is now in the MS Gym.

-Nevada High School: Hired five new teachers for next year - Prioritization of standards at NHS every department; which links to formative assessments (NHS Building Goal 21-22)

-Nevada HS Students: Students happy to finish the year in-person and have a majority of activities as normal; Graduation in May; Girls Golf - 8th Place and Girls Soccer play in State tomorrow (June 8th).

-Time Line: July 1, 2021 - Sept 30th, 2023

-At least 20% must be spent to address learning loss

-Expendurite Plan:

-Summer School 2022: \$40,000 (Summer School 2021= ESSER II) *Address "learning loss"

-Elementary Sped/Reading Endorsement: \$60,000 (salary/benefits) x2 *2021-22 and 2022-23 school year

*Provide flexibility in staffing to add an Interventionist (Literacy, Math, and Behaviors)

*Increase intervention implementation due to increase in learning loss among elementary students

-Elementary 1-2 Multiage Teacher: \$60,000 (salary/benefits) x2 *2021-22 and 2022-23 school year *Reduction in class sizes to below 25 students per class - assist with social distancing and decrease student-to-teacher ratio to assist with interventions attributed to learning loss

-Middle School 5-6 Special Education: \$60,000 (salary/benefits) x2

*2021-22 and 2022-23 school year

*Provide flexibility in staffing to add an Interventionist (Literacy, Math, and Behaviors)

*Increase intervention implementation due to increase in learning loss among middle school students

-Code School Counselors (4) and Nurses (2) salaries over the next two years (2021-22 and 2022-23) to ESSER III: \$919,576.00

-Total: \$1,279,57.00 of \$1,298,023.00 allocation

-This plan provides an expenditure cushion to our General Fund of \$1,000,000+
