- -PK-4 Math Curriculum (seeking School Board approval on 4/4/22)
  - -The Nevada CSD SIAC committee supports the recommendation to adapt a new Math curriculum for students in Grade K-4
- -Grades 5-8 Math Curriculum (School Board communication on 3/7/22)
  - -Concerns regarding the Self-Paced program were voiced by both parents and students along with questions and intended expectations for students in both pathways.
  - -The Nevada CSD SIAC committee supports the recommendation to adapt a new Math pathway for students in Grades 5-8.
