## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING MONDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2022 GATES MEMORIAL HALL AT 825 15TH STREET

- 1. Call to Order at 6:30 p.m.
- **2. Approval of Agenda** The closed session and the following open session on the original Board agenda will be removed. Motion by Maier, second by Hayek to approve the agenda as amended. Motion Carried 5-0
- 3. Public Comment none
- **5.1 Snow Removal Bids** When the current snow removal vendor resigned, the District pursued eight vendors for snow removal for the years 2022-25. Of those eight, four indicated plans to submit bids. A follow-up with those four yielded only one bid from Con-Struct. Dr. Gray said he recommended approval of this bid as it was comparable to the last bid received. Motion by Maier, second by Anderson to approve the snow removal bid from Con-Struct. Motion Carried 5-0
- **5.2 Snow Removal Equipment** Dr. Gray said that administration recommends the equipment purchase in the amount of \$35,600 for a new subcompact utility tractor for the District crew to complete snow removal and liquid ice melt applications on sidewalks as well as other summer duties as needed. The District currently shares one machine for both the Middle School and High School and completion prior to staff/student arrival can be a challenge. In addition, any type of breakdown would leave the District with only one machine for all buildings. Motion by Anderson, second by Harter to approve purchasing outdoor maintenance equipment from Van Wall Equipment for \$35,500. Motion Carried 5-0
- **5.3 FY24 Bus Bids** Busses for purchase next July 1 need approval with nine-month lead time. The bus to be purchased includes propane fueling, 77 passenger capacity, fiberglass undercarriage, and seat belted (3 point) bus. Fiberglass spares the District from the problems with the metal undercarriage. Low bid for the bus was from School Bus Sales for \$133,952 payable from PPEL. Motion by Maier, second by Harter to approve purchase of the bus from School Bus Sales. Motion Carried 5-0
- **5.4 IASB Policy Updates** Dr. Gray said he recommends approval of the Board policy changes suggested by the Iowa Association of School Boards (IASB) after the most recent Legislative session. Dr. Gray answered various questions from the Board on these policy changes. Motion by Maier to approve the first reading of the proposed Board Policy updates, second by Hayek. Motion Carried 5-0
