## 3. Public Comment - none

- 4.1 FY24 Budget Presentation Schaeffer presented the budget information as proposed for the 2023-24 school year. This was in the format used for the past several years which reviewed "School Funding 101", enrollment, 2.5% State Supplemental Aid, and Unspent Authorized Budget. The new budget's revenues and expenditures were also reviewed. The tax levy recommendation will be the same as for this year: \$14.71 per thousand taxable value. This levy will also allow the District to retire \$260,000 from the High School G O Bonds to save interest. The Board asked questions about how to increase enrollment and Hayek suggested a survey of students as to why more were coming via open enrollment. Anderson asked for a count of open enrolled in and out by districts. Hayek asked students enrolled in PreSchool. Dr. Gray said that the enrollment in PreSchool is declining similar to the overall certified enrollment count for the District.
- **5.1 Policy 105 Assistance Animals Final Reading** Dr. Gray brought back Policy 105 "Assistance Animals" for its final approval reading. This had been reviewed by the Board at their last two meetings. Motion by Anderson, second by Maier to approve the final reading of Policy 105. Motion Carried 5-0
