District Level Goals

District's Long Range Reading Goals for K-6 Literacy

1. By the year 2023, 80% of students in grades 1st-6th will be at or above benchmark on the FAST Assessments.
2. In the winter of 2022, 79% of students in grades 1st-4th grade were at or above benchmark on the FAST assessment. By the winter of 2023, we will increase that percentage to 80%.

Building Level Goals

Central Elementary Goals:

1. By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 92% of First-Fourth grade students will meet grade-level expectations or show one year of growth in reading.
2. By the end of 2022-2023, all classroom teachers will have implemented a CASEL "SElect" program and will use the DESSA for assessment and data-driven tier 2 interventions and support.
3. By the end of 2022-2023, all K-4 classroom teachers will have implemented Bridges mathematics curriculum in their classrooms

Nevada Middle School Goal:

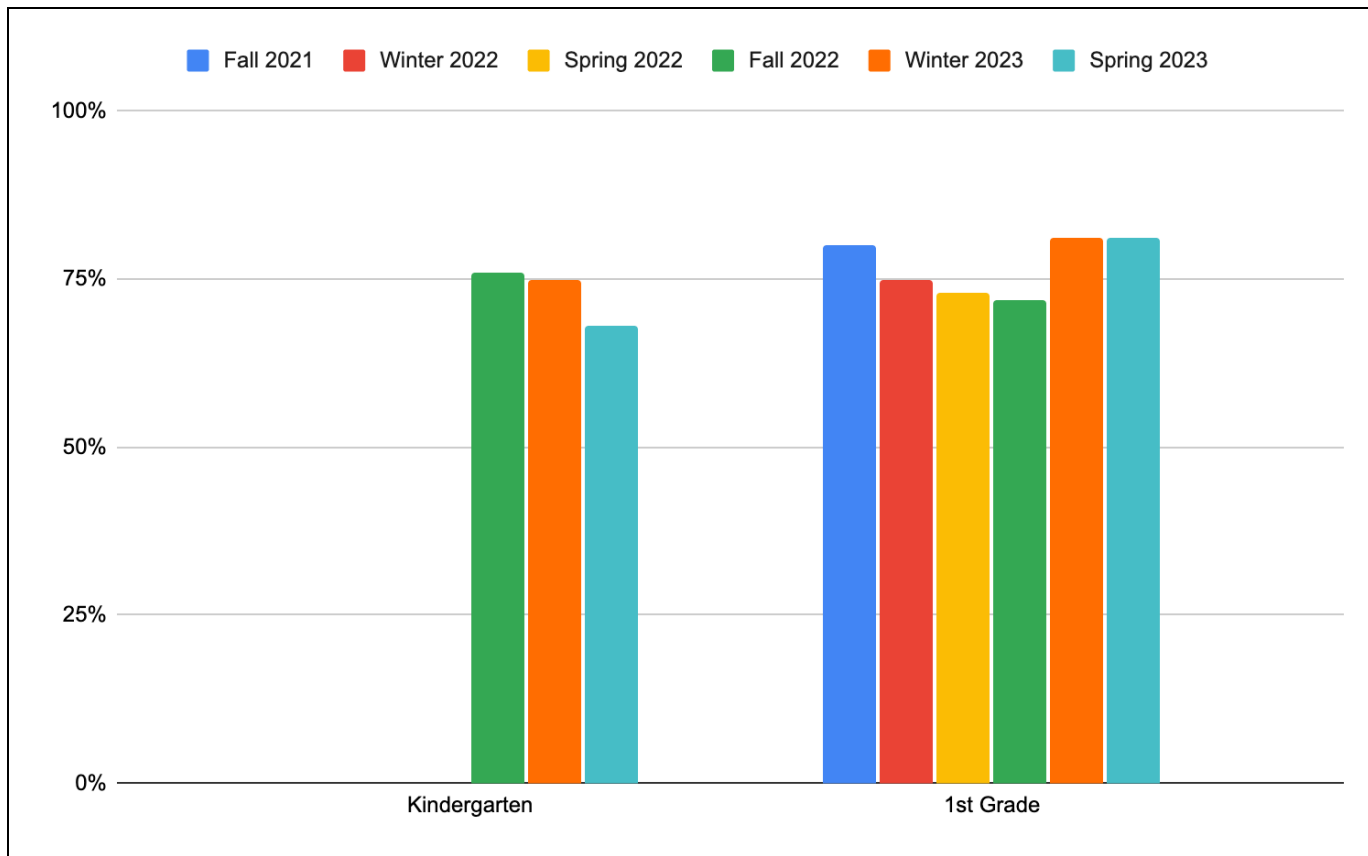
1. To improve student learning by improving the implementation fidelity of MTSS and enhance student well-being through incorporating SEL components by the end of the 22-23 school year.

2. Through SEL professional development and learning opportunities, NHS staff will increase implementation of SEL practices in the classroom and grow climate and culture within the building.

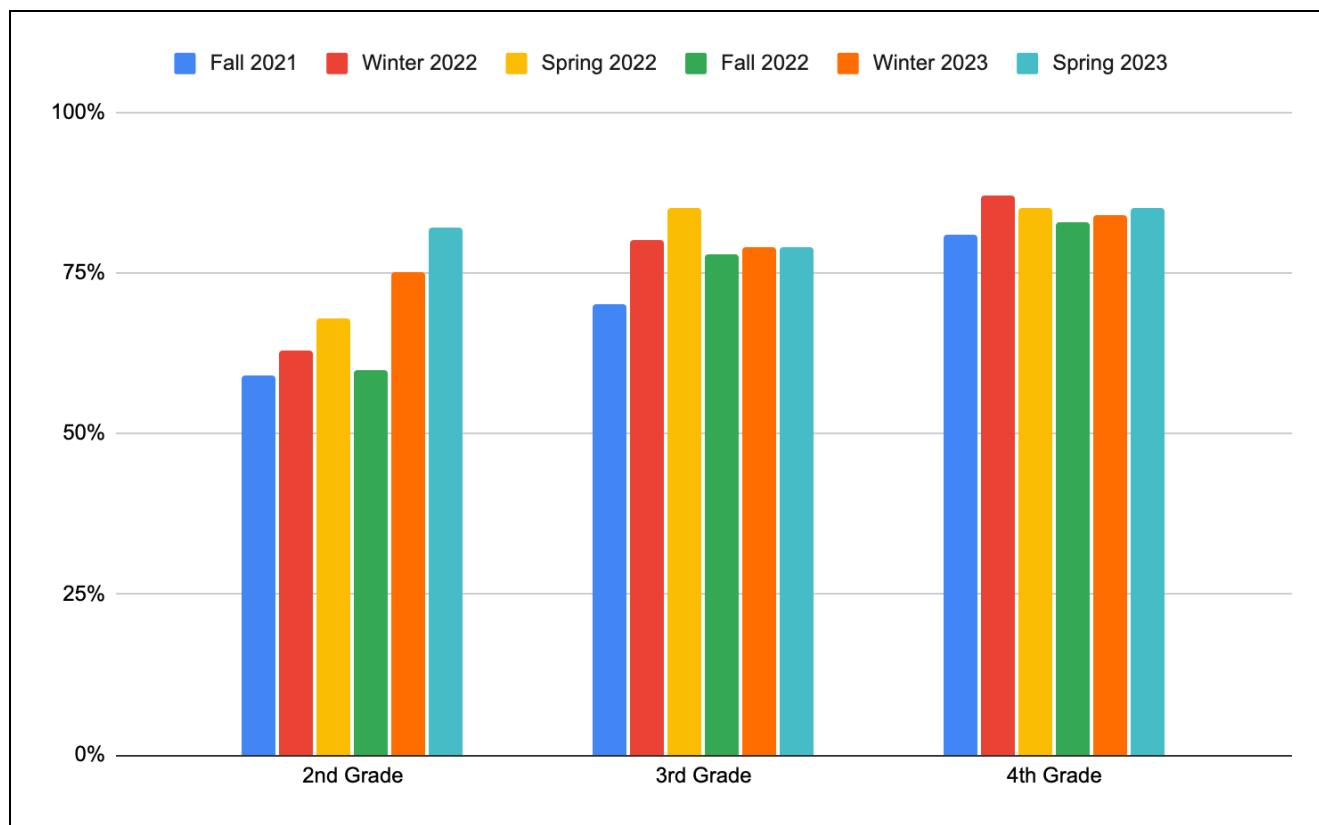

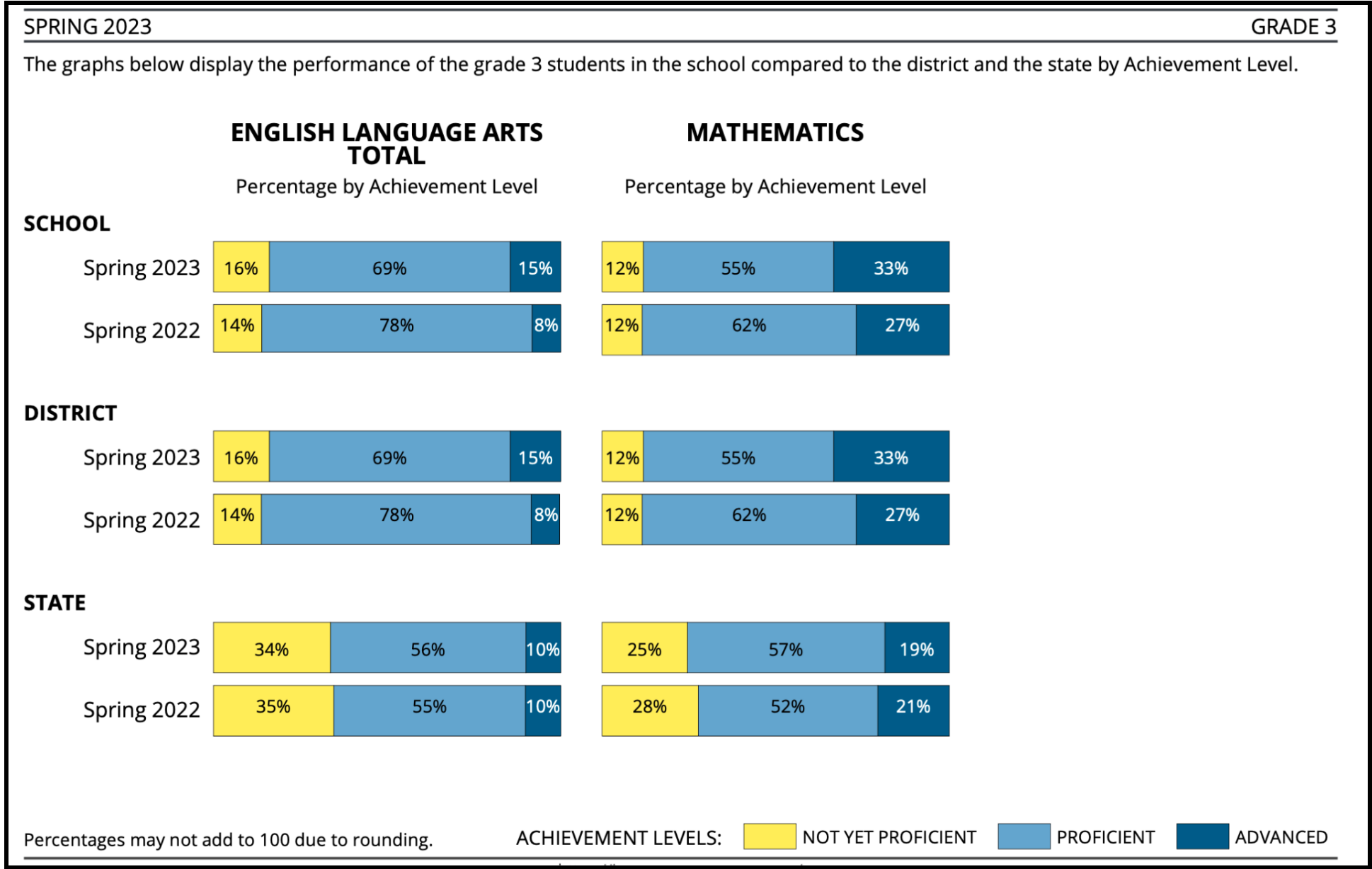

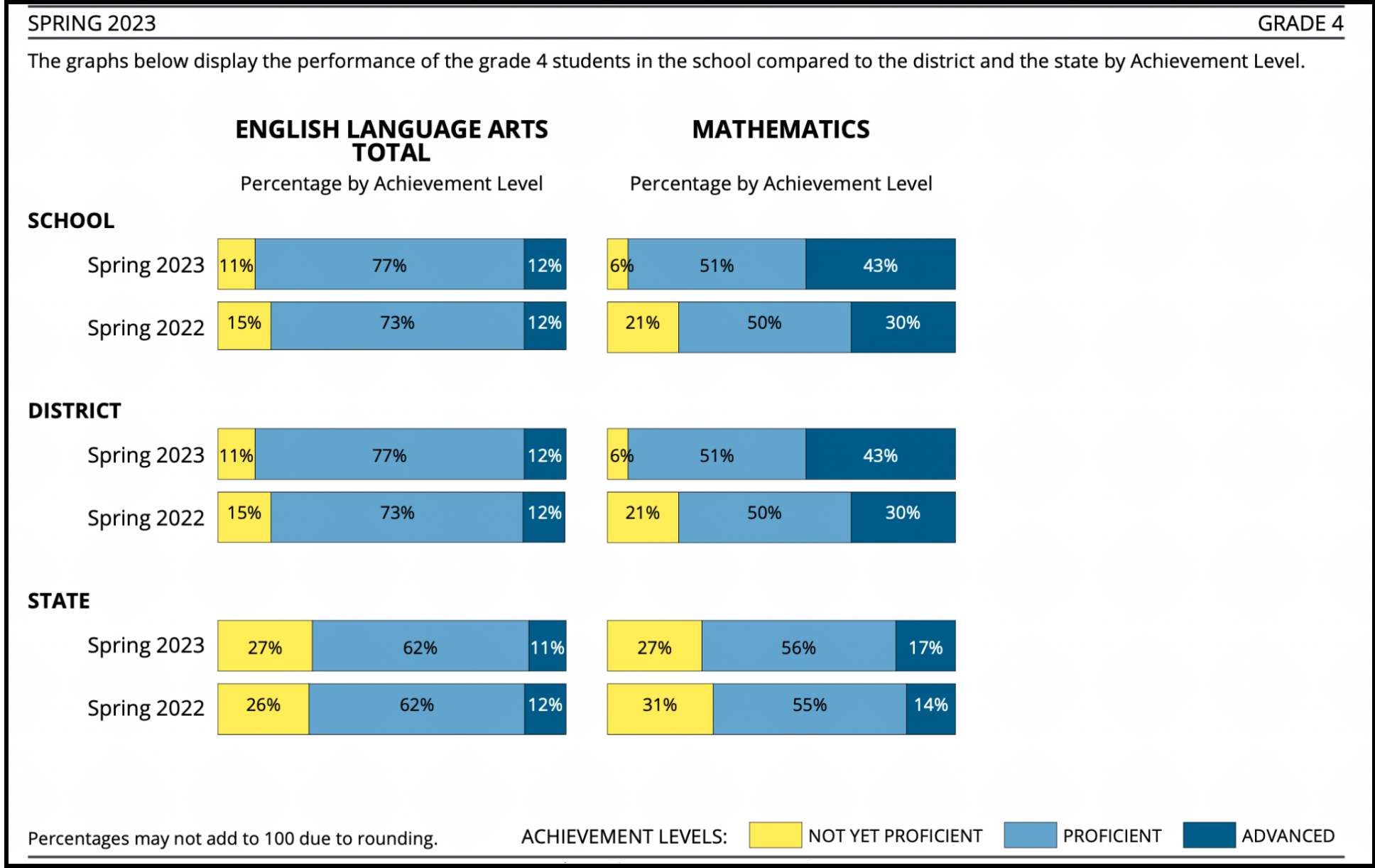

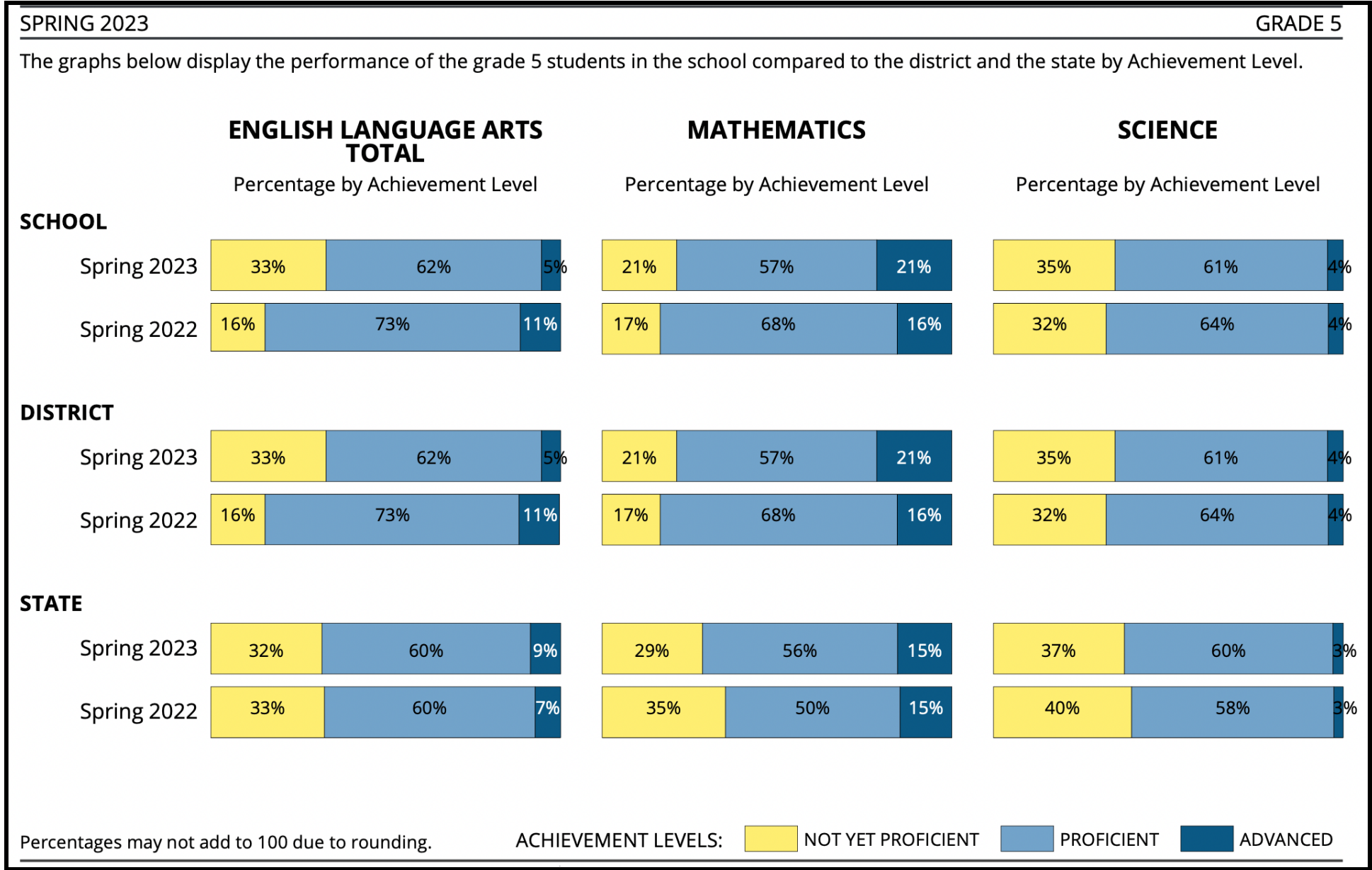
Spring 2023 3rd Grade ISASP Data



Spring 2023 4th Grade ISASP Data

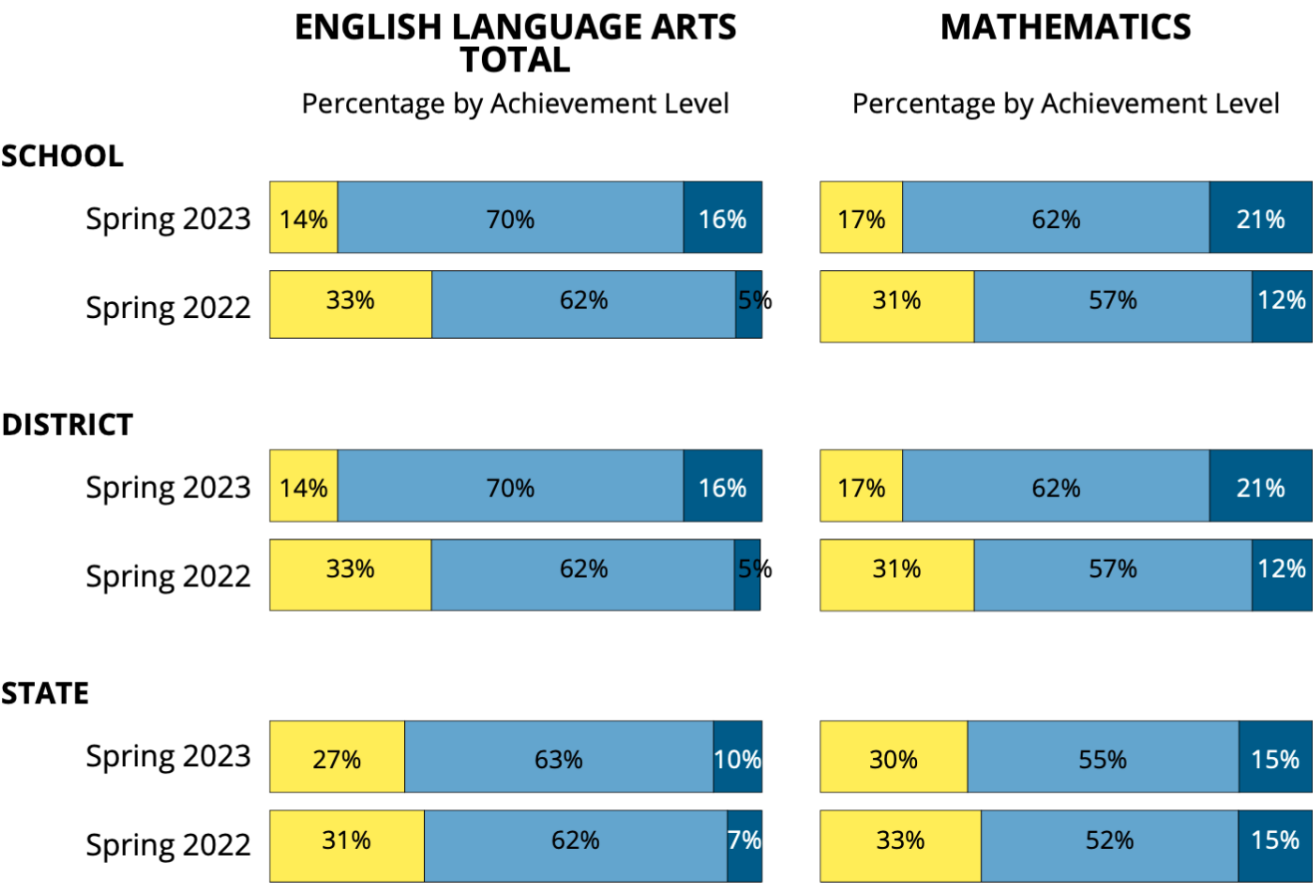

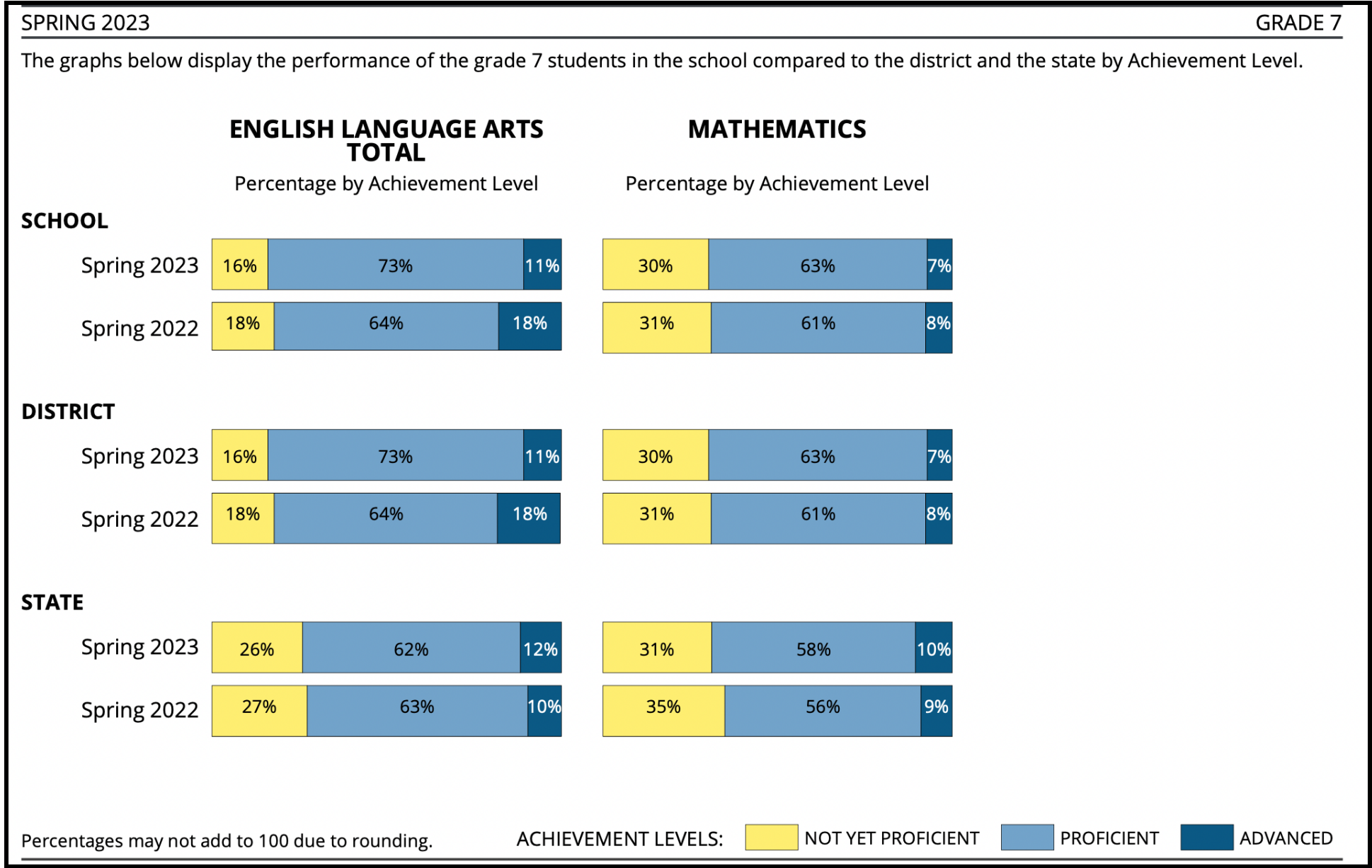

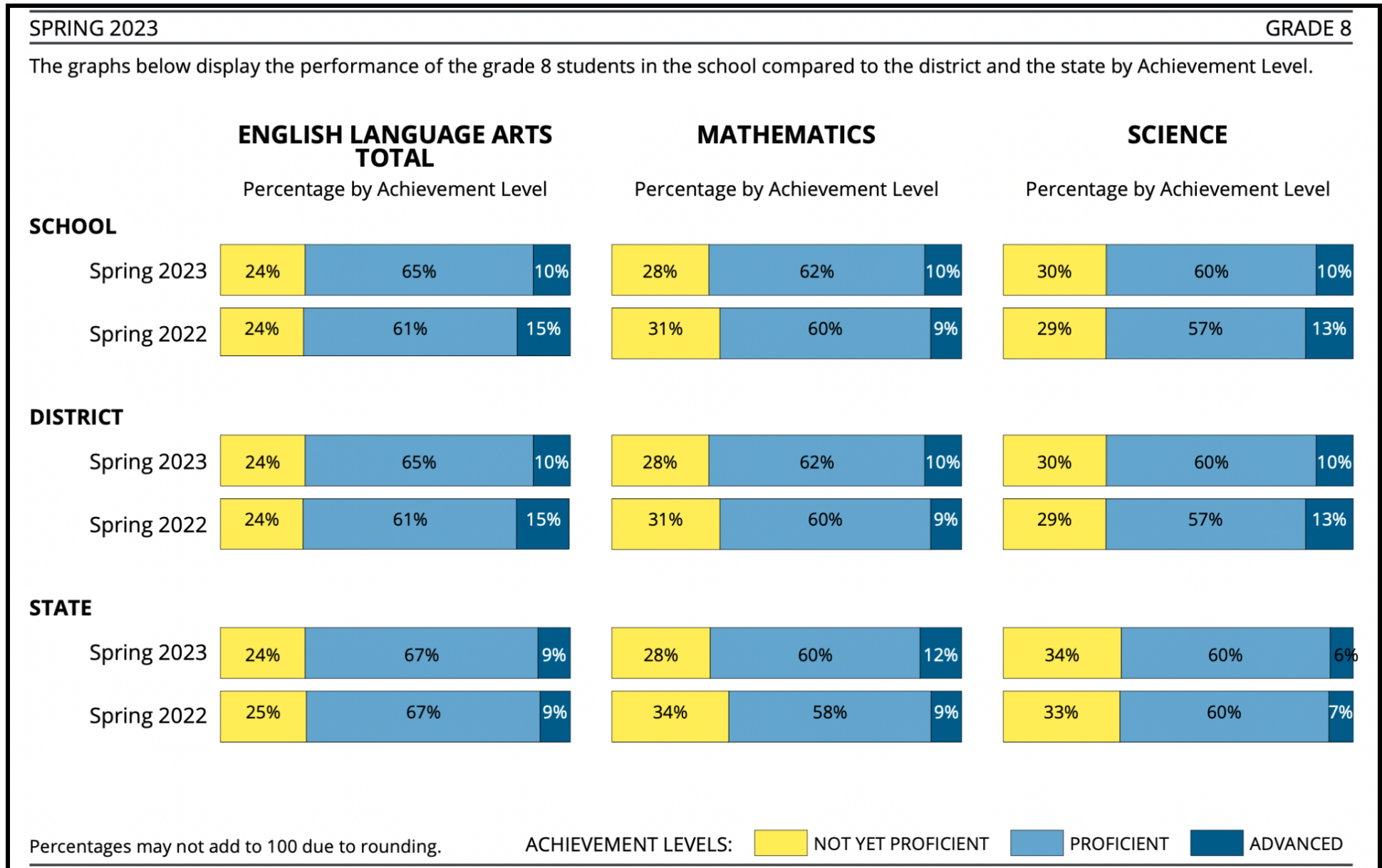

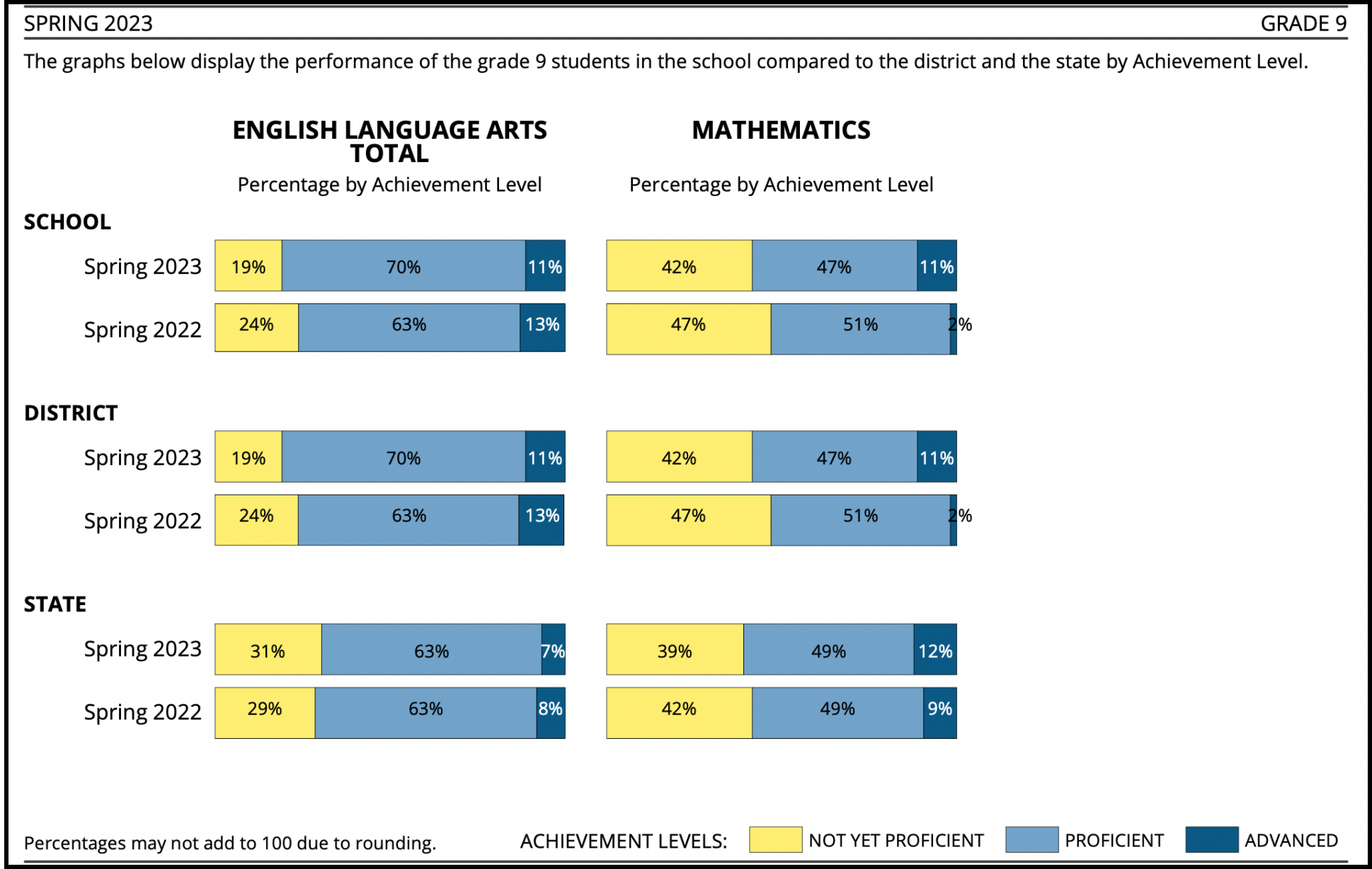

Percentage by Achievement Level

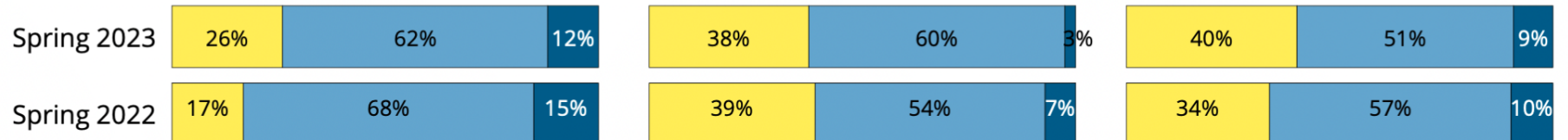

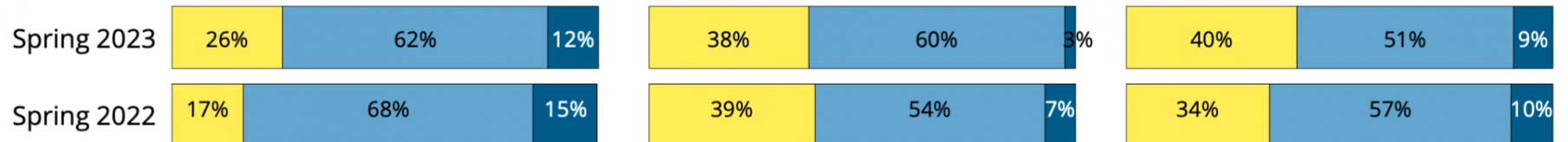

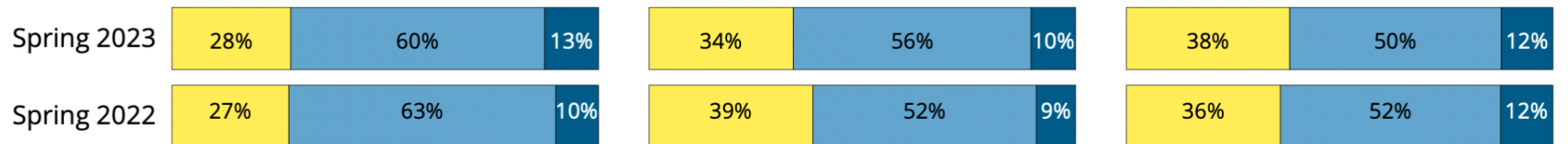

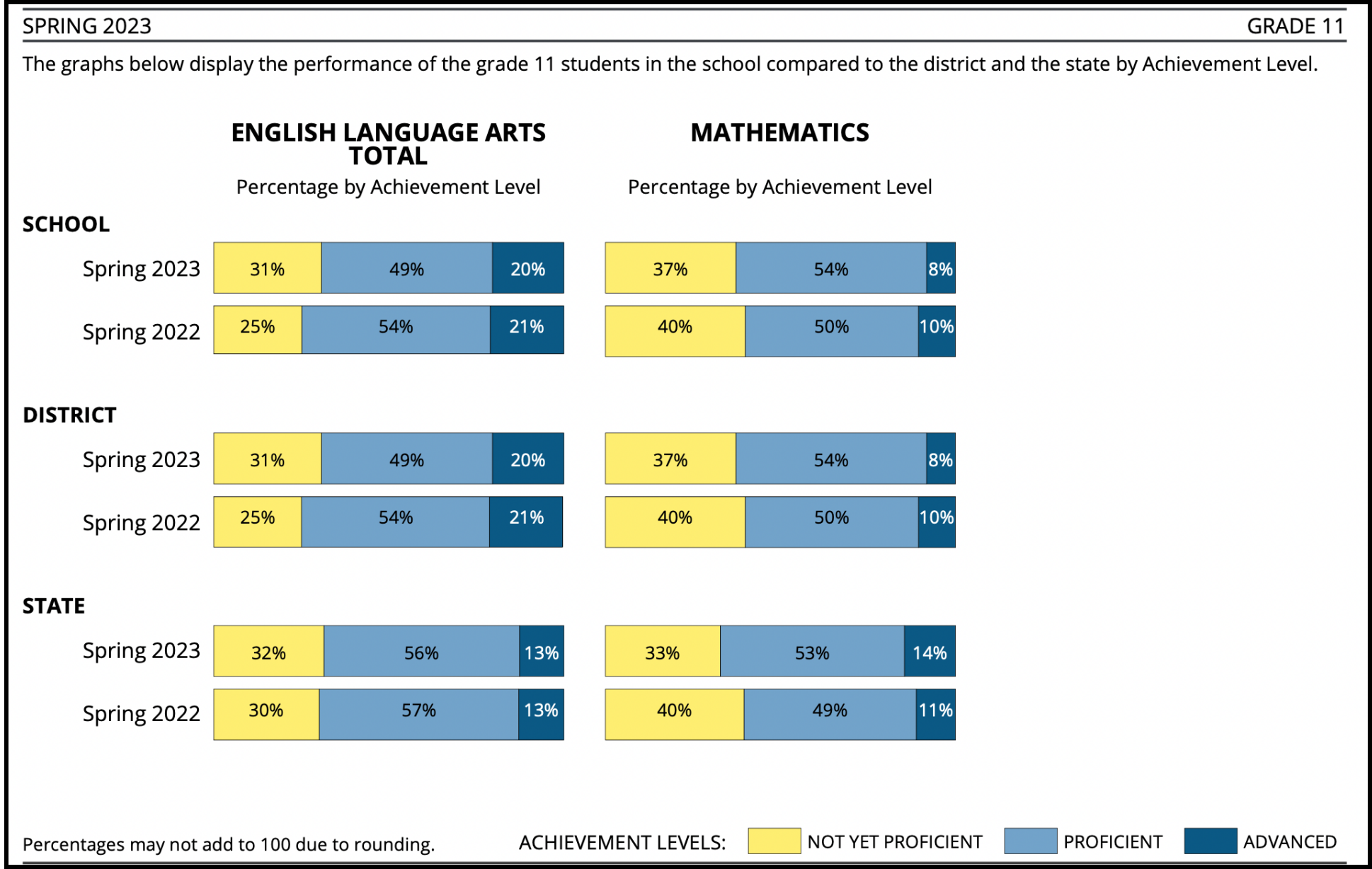

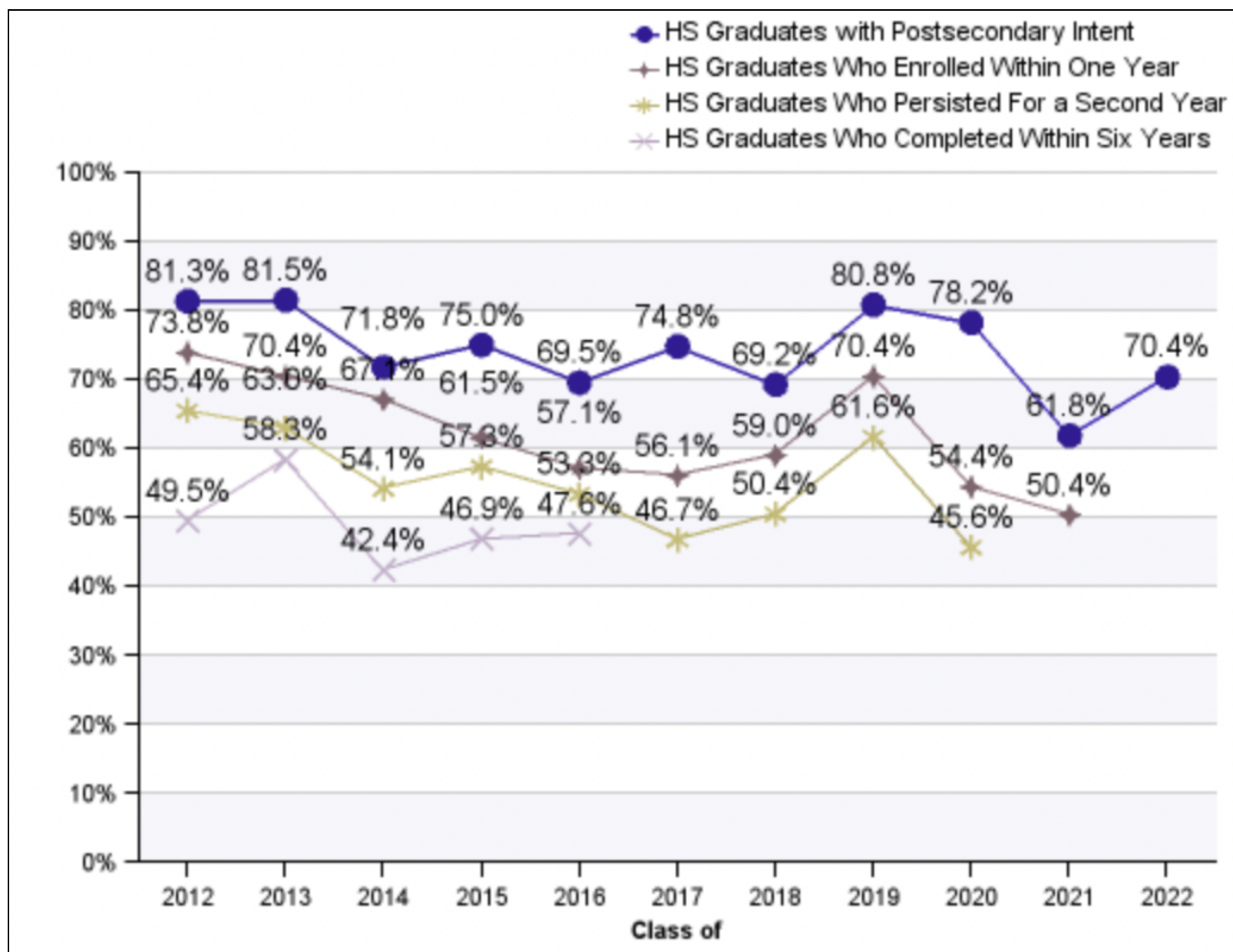

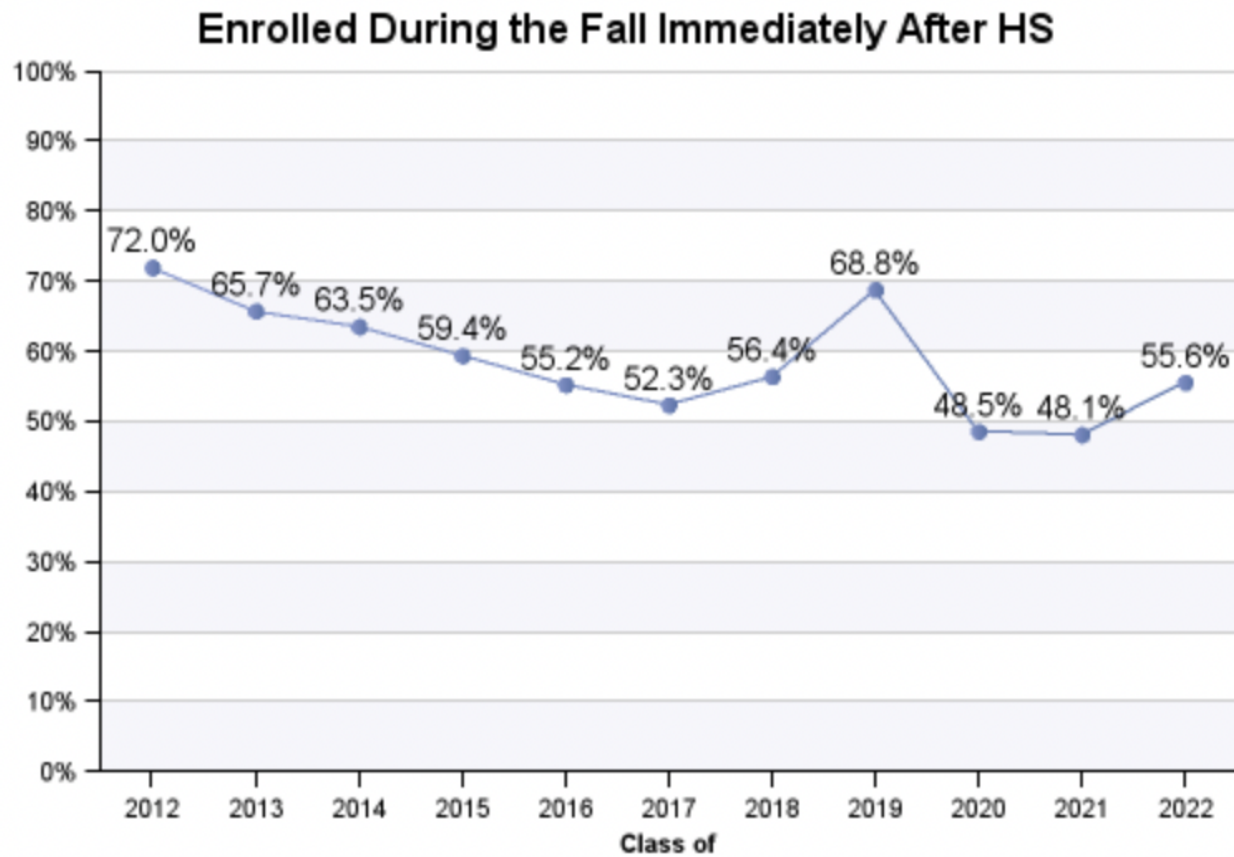

Nevada High School Graduates - Postsecondary Enrollment Trends



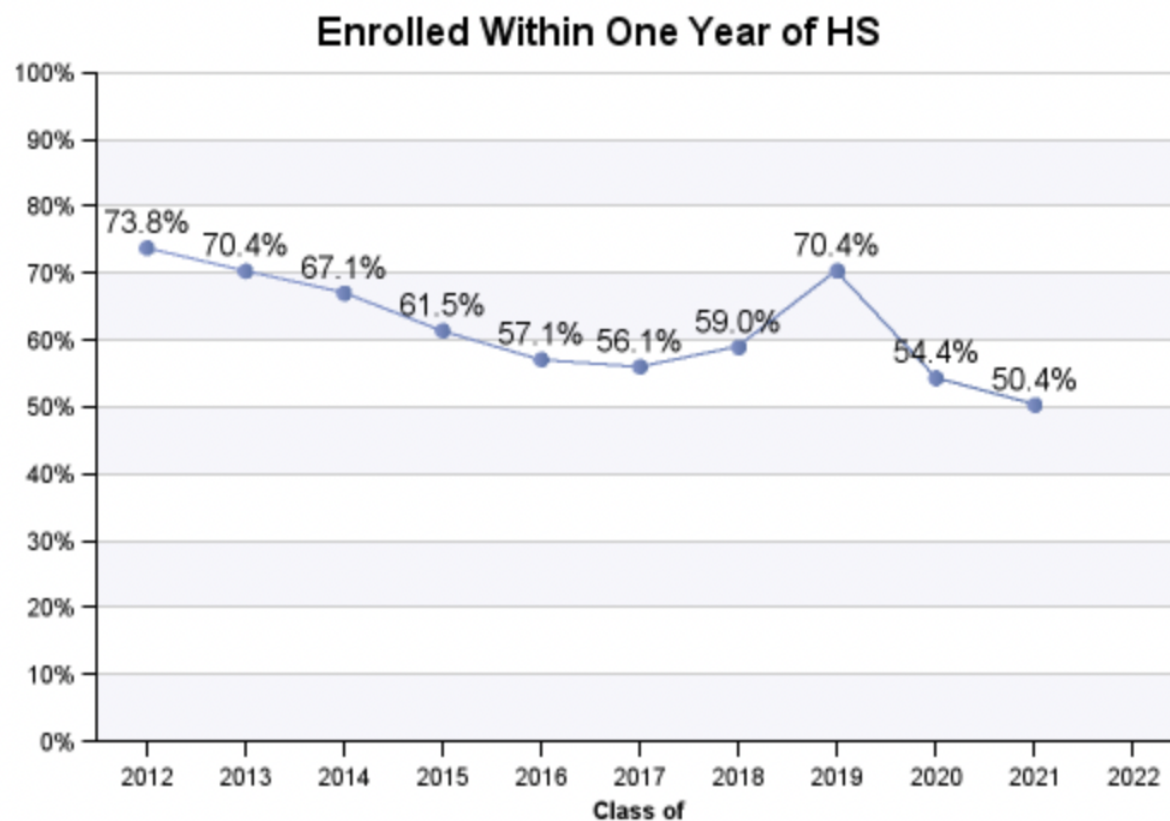

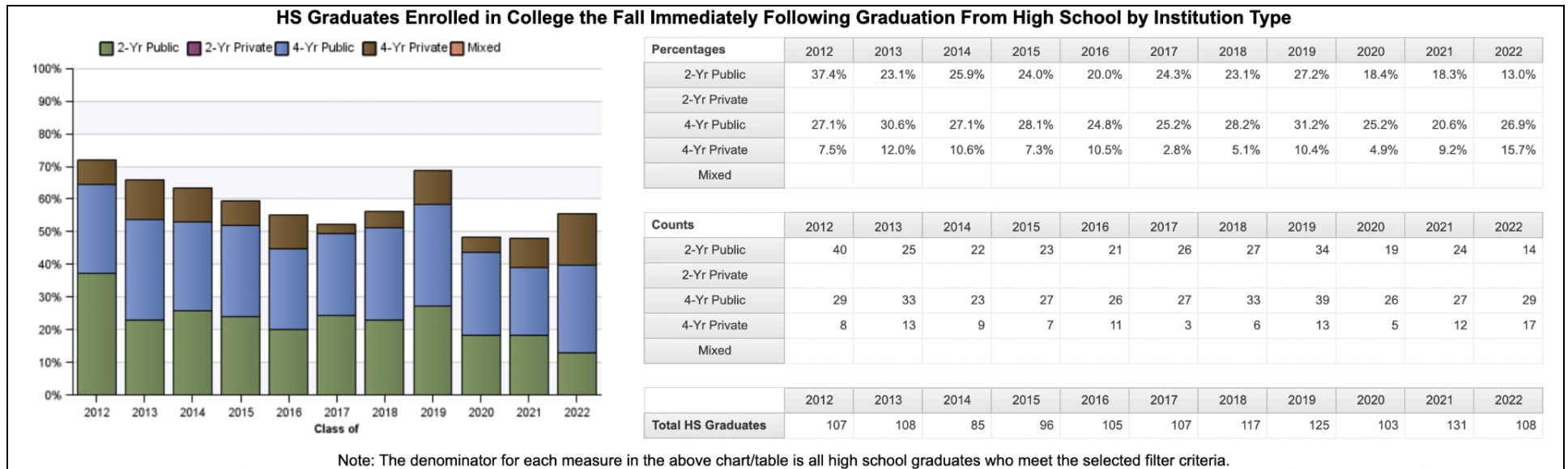

Nevada High School Graduates - Postsecondary Enrollment Trends



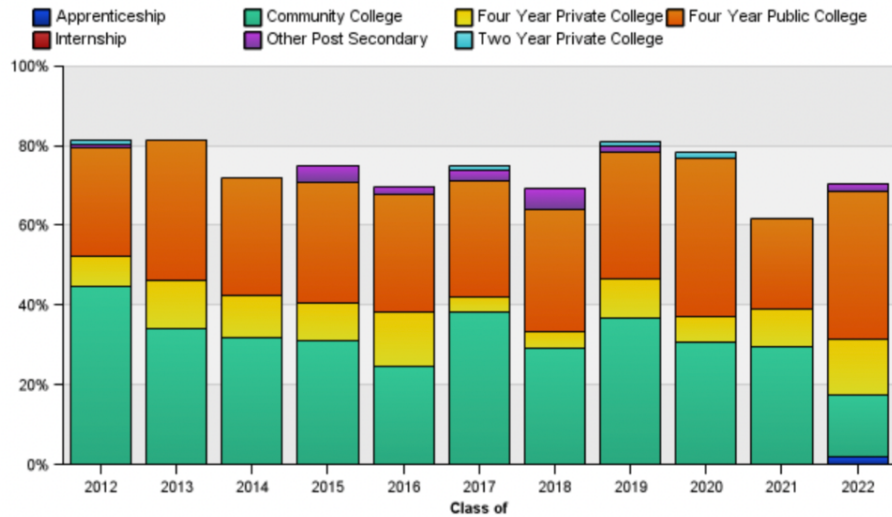
