2: Purpose of the School Improvement Advisory Committee (SIAC)

-(Per Iowa Code 280.12) -- To serve in an advisory role and make recommendations to the board of directors regarding:

- Major educational needs
- Student learning goals
- Long-range and annual improvement goals that include, but are not limited to, the state indicators that address reading, mathematics, and science achievement.
- > Desired levels of student performance.
- Progress toward meeting the goals
- Harassment or bullying prevention goals, programs, training, and other initiatives.
- > Infusing character education into the educational program

2: Building and Student Updates

-Central Elementary: Professional Development: Literacy (Jen Burns) - Literacy Footprints and Math (Emily Rash) - Bridges, FAST coming up, Leveling for 1st-4th Readers, and Day @ the Hill presentation (Literacy improvement)

-Nevada Middle School: Meeting in Curricular/Grade-Level Teams - SMART Goals, SEL Learning/Implementation, Winter Concerts - Band/Choir, Nov/Dec sports season wrapping up, the start of Jan/Feb season coming up, and a variety of trips for the MS students, and FAST testing coming up.

-Nevada High School: SEL PD - focus on climate/culture in the building, teachers sharing in-class examples, Formative/Summative Assessments, Winter Activities in full Swing, Winter Concerts in December, and developing MTSS plan/team.

-Nevada HS Students: Basketball (good start for both teams), Wrestling in full swing hosted a large Central Iowa meet; team success for both, Musical (*Footloose*) auditions - casting comes out on Friday, Science Bowl starting (largest number of participants - two teams), Ethics Bowl starting, eSports is rolling, Seminar Olympics start of the 2nd semester, Speech season is coming up - high level of participation, State Dance in DSM - 2 soloist, 3 teams, and flag-line participated - performing a game and clinic coming up, and Orientation coming up in mid-January.
