2: Purpose of the School Improvement Advisory Committee (SIAC)

- Major educational needs
- Student learning goals
- Long-range and annual improvement goals that include, but are not limited to, the state indicators that address reading, mathematics, and science achievement.
- Desired levels of student performance.
- Progress toward meeting the goals
- Harassment or bullying prevention goals, programs, training, and other initiatives.
- Infusing character education into the educational program

- Central Elementary:
 - ELA: 80% or above
 - Math: 90% or above
- Nevada Middle School:
 - ELA: 85% or above
 - Math: 85% or above
 - Science (5th and 8th grade only): 75% or above
- Nevada High School:
 - ELA: 80% or above
 - Math: 70% or above
 - Science (10th grade only): 75% or above
