

- 2. Through SEL professional development and learning opportunities, NHS staff will increase the implementation of SEL practices in the classroom and grow the climate and culture within the building.




### **Spring 2024 3rd Grade ISASP Data**




### **Spring 2024 4th Grade ISASP Data**




