2: Purpose of the School Improvement Advisory Committee (SIAC)

-(Per Iowa Code 280.12) -- To serve in an advisory role and make recommendations to the board of directors regarding:

- > Major educational needs
- > Student learning goals
- ➤ Long-range and annual improvement goals that include, but are not limited to, the state indicators that address reading, mathematics, and science achievement.
- > Desired levels of student performance.
- Progress toward meeting the goals
- > Harassment or bullying prevention goals, programs, training, and other initiatives.
- > Infusing character education into the educational program

4: NCSD 2025-26 Title I, IIA, and IVA Service Plan

- > Title I Nearly 180K
 - Required Homeless Set Aside: \$1,000

- Literacy + Intervention Supports Salary + Benefits: Remaining amount (\$179,085.79 in FY25)
 - Title I Teachers @ Central Elementary
- o SIAC Recommendation: Approve the plan outlined above
- ➤ Title IIA Nearly 36K (*expected*)
 - Option #1:
 - Classroom Size Reduction Salary + Benefits: Full amount allocated (\$35,896.99 in FY25)
 - Local Needs Assessment:
 - Estimated 2025-26 3rd Grade Enrollment: 57 students
 - Current # of 3rd Grade Teachers: 2.0 FTE
 - Class sizes: 28 and 29
 - Add an additional FTE to 3rd grade 3 teachers
 - Class sizes: 19, 19, and 19
 - Assurance Questions:
 - Licensed Teacher in every K-3 classroom: Yes
 - Highly qualified + effective teacher who adjust instructional strategies for learners: Yes
 - Option 2:
 - LETRS Training (Elementary + MS Teachers): \$12,000
 - Cognitive Coaching (PD New Learning Team Coaches): \$3,000
 - Building a Reader PD (Central Elementary): \$5,000
 - SEL PD Consultants: \$12,000
 - Additional PD/Training TBD: \$4,000
 - SIAC Recommendation: Approve the plan outlined above with a focus on Option #1 using the funds to add a teacher in 3rd grade to reduce class size from 28 and 29
 students in each section (2) to 19 students in each section (3).
